It's been a banner year for Greater Family Health. Coming out of the peak of a pandemic, while also opening up 2 new Health Centers and 2 new offices, our high-performing professionals achieved some pretty remarkable outcomes:

Access to Care: Record amounts of clients/patients cared for, as well as volume of care provided, including in our new Palatine and Franklin Park locations.

Clinical Quality: 3 National Quality Awards received, including clinical outcomes ranked in the top 10% in the U.S., and 3 more Awards received from American Medical Association and American Heart Association.

Cost: Greater Family Health's cost per patient is 38% less than the Illinois Average.

Compliance: Re-Accreditation by The Joint Commission in Primary Care & Primary Care Medical Home, and Behavioral Health Care for the 1st time.

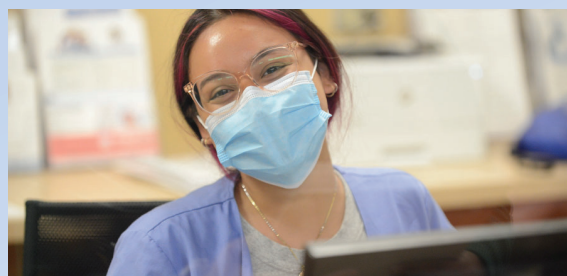

Back in the Community



Although the COVID-19 pandemic is far from over, Greater Family Health is working hard on resuming activities in our continued effort to return to a resemblance of normalcy. The COVID-19 pandemic has exposed an uneven vulnerability to health inequities, with the most disadvantaged groups bearing the most significant health, social, and economic burden. To continue advocating for vulnerable populations, Greater Family Health ensured community members knew we would be there in their time of need.

COVID-19 Outreach

Greater Family Health continues to play an integral role in the fight against COVID-19. We continue offering various COVID-19 tests, vaccinations, and treatments. In January 2022, Greater Family Health began providing community partners access QuickVue At-Home COVID-19 Test Kits and N-95 masks to increase testing availability and ensure the community has the tools to protect themselves. From February 2022 to August 31st, 2022, Greater Family Health distributed over 20,120 at-home test kits to patients and community partners in Elgin and Hanover Townships, as well as Chinese Mutual Aid, Family Health Partnership Clinic and Children's Home + Aid.

"Hanover Township is very grateful to Greater Family Health for their support and partnership in supplying the Township with at home COVID-19 test kits to distribute to residents. This valuable resource has allowed the Township to increase accessibility of testing options for residents and in turn improve safety in the community through the quick identification of COVID-19, allowing individuals to make informed decisions for isolation and quarantine guidance. The availability of COVID-19 testing, especially for our most vulnerable populations, continues to be an integral component in safely resuming programs, services and normal operations in the community."

Gail Borden Public Library's TechKnow Mobile is a one-stop technology assistance vehicle working to address and mend digital and technological inequities in Elgin and surrounding communities.

Growing Greater: Serving the Communities of Palatine and Franklin Park



Greater Family Health's mission is to provide quality, affordable health care for all, including those without the ability to pay. One way of ensuring we provide quality and affordable health care is to help residents find convenient access to care near their work, home, and school. After several years of planning and delay due to the pandemic, Greater Family Health opened two new Health Centers in 2022.

Palatine

On March 7, 2022, Greater Family Health opened its tenth Health Center at 345 W. Northwest Highway in Palatine, Illinois. The Health Center features eight examination rooms, one behavioral health office, and two laboratories, including a full-service laboratory operated by LabCorp and a CLIA-waived lab for point-of-care testing. Family Medicine, Pediatrics, Behavioral Health and Substance Use Disorder services are offered, including complete laboratory services. Medical Director Olha Mendyuk, Family Nurse Practitioner Lindsey Mattes, Physician Assistant Neelam Patel, Certified Nurse Midwife Leta Vaught, Dr. Margaret Nettleton, OB/GYN, and Licensed Clinical Social Work Phylicia Headley.

In the development of Greater Family Health's location in Palatine, Northwest Community Hospital (NCH) Foundation shared considerable resources to support the renovation and equipping of the site. On May 19, 2022, led by President/CEO Bob Tanner, Greater Family Health held a festive Grand Opening and Ribbon Cutting celebration that included several comments, delicious food and treats, and recognition of the generosity of John and Rita Canning and the NCH Foundation.

On July 25, 2022, Greater Family Health continued further expansion of its high-quality, affordable primary health care services, focusing on residents of Franklin Park, Schiller Park, Stone Park, Northlake, unincorporated Cook and DuPage Counties and the surrounding communities with a Health Center located at 10225 Grand Avenue in Franklin Park, Illinois. The Health Center in Franklin Park includes fifteen examination rooms, two behavioral health offices, a full-service laboratory operated by LabCorp, and a CLIA-waived laboratory for point-of-care testing. Medical Director Dr. Engjellush Sadik, Physician Assistants Christen Alcorido and Amanda Corral and Licensed Clinical Social Worker Phylicia Headley began providing care to an area very much in need of a trusted, reliable and affordable primary care practice.

These behavioral health services are offered to all patients at our Health Centers in Elgin, Hanover Park, McHenry, Sycamore and Wheeling, and in our new Health Centers in Franklin Park and Palatine.



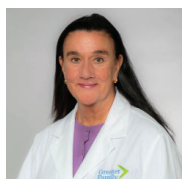

Health Benefits Enrollment Expansion

According to the latest American Community Survey data, over twenty-eight million people in the U.S. lack health insurance coverage. Not only does lack of insurance coverage affect people's physical health, but it also puts their mental and financial health at risk. Health insurance coverage is critical to living a healthy, productive, secure life and provides access to affordable medical, dental and behavioral health services, pharmaceuticals, diagnostic and subspecialty care, and in-hospital care.

Greater Family Health understands that obtaining health insurance can be a confusing and tedious process that can deter patients from applying. That is why Greater Family Health offers Health Benefits Enrollment services to community residents, free of cost, at any of our eleven Health Centers.

In addition to traditional Medicaid and Access to Care, Health Benefits Specialists employed by Greater Family Health help individuals apply for Medicare and Medicaid-like health plans, such as the Health Benefits for Immigrant Adults and the Health Benefits for Immigrant Seniors programs. Enrollment assistance also provides for all plans offered on Get Covered Illinois, expanding the breadth of insurance options our patients have and improving their access to care.

Expanding Sexual Health Services



In March of 2022, Greater Family Health was informed that the organization was awarded Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Part C Outpatient Early Intervention Services Program funding.

The \$310,829 annual funding from the Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA) supports Greater Family Health's existing comprehensive primary health care and support services for low-income, uninsured, and underserved people with HIV residing in DeKalb, DuPage, Kane, Kendall, McHenry, and the northwest portion of Cook counties in Illinois. The funding allows Greater Family Health to further identify, support and care for those with HIV residing in DeKalb, DuPage, Kane, Kendall, McHenry, and a portion of Cook counties in Illinois.

The resources complement Greater Family Health's existing medical Case Management, outreach, education and testing and will allow to provide further:

- Counseling for individuals concerning HIV
- Periodic medical evaluations of individuals
- Therapeutic measures for preventing
- Treating the deterioration of the immune system and preventing and treating conditions arising from HIV
- Referrals for people with HIV to appropriate providers of health and support services.

"Greater Family Health has substantially expanded its outreach, education, testing, case management and care provision for those at greatest risk for HIV/AIDS, as well as those diagnosed with HIV," indicated Bob Tanner, President and CEO of Greater Family Health. "Our patients indicate very high satisfaction with these services, offered by our team of caring, dedicated and skilled professionals, including our practitioners. We are thrilled that HRSA recognizes our value, capabilities and successes, awarding Greater Family Health this funding, which nicely complements our existing funding and services," he continued.

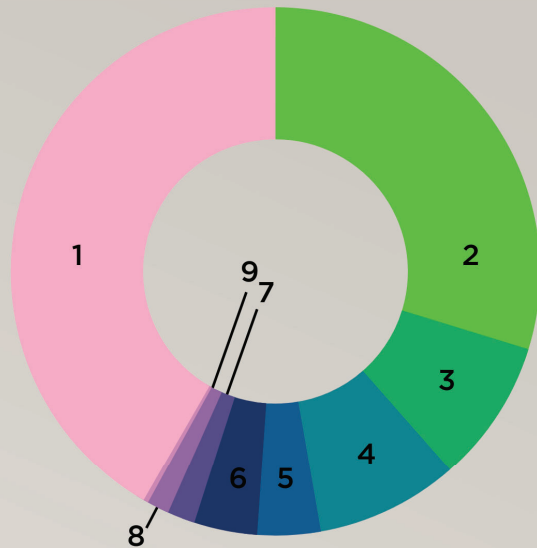

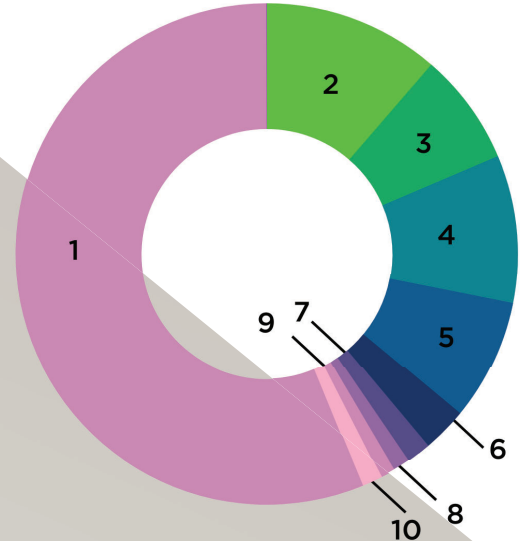

During Greater Family Health's Grand Opening and Ribbon Cutting of their Health Center in Palatine, President/CEO of Northwest Community Healthcare, Stephen Scogna, spoke to the long-standing and valuable partnership of Greater Family Health and Northwest Community Hospital, noting the positive impact on the health of local communities as a result of the collaboration. He specifically noted the innovative model of prenatal and obstetrics care developed in 2016 to address an unmet need for under-resourced women.

In conjunction with Northwest Community Healthcare and an initial \$1 million grant from John and Rita Canning, Greater Family Health created a way to bring physicians and obstetrics care to Greater Family Health's Wheeling location and follow that care through to delivery at NCH. The Cannings' generosity was followed by a second \$1 million grant to continue the program's success at the Wheeling location and expand it to Greater Family Health's site in Palatine to help construct and equip the location.

"We are proud to support Northwest Community Healthcare's involvement in improving the lives of women and children in our community and their partnership with Greater Family Health. Sadly, many of these women didn't have access to the care they needed but now they do and children have a better start to life because of it," said Rita Canning.

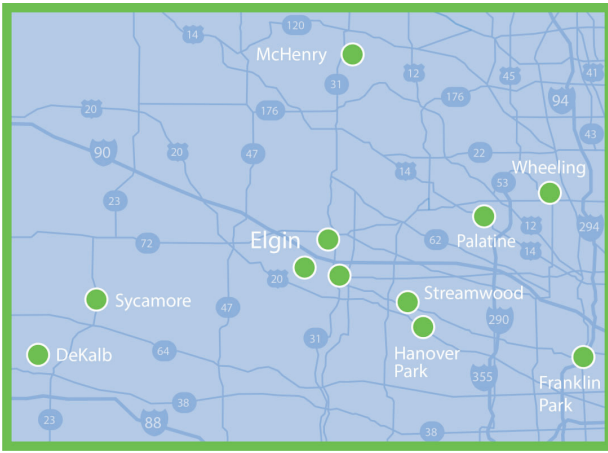

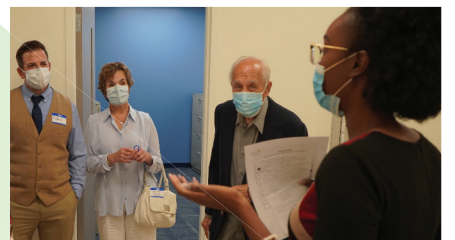
